5. Cookies

If we use non-essential cookies (such as analytics), we will ask for your consent via a cookie banner. You can manage or withdraw consent at any time through your browser settings. We may also use Cloudflare Web Analytics, a privacy-first, cookie-free service, to understand website traffic in aggregate. This does not require cookies or collect personal data.

6. How long we keep your data

- Contact enquiries: usually up to 2 years.
- Business records: kept for as long as necessary to manage our relationship and meet legal requirements.
- Marketing data: until you withdraw consent or opt out.

7. Your rights

Under UK GDPR you have rights, including to:

- Access the data we hold about you.
- Ask us to correct or delete your data.
- Restrict or object to how we use it.
- Withdraw consent (where consent was given).
